This week we wrapped our Ball Study and color fun with some really great activities. In small groups, we practiced letter identification with letter stamps and made our first names with the stamps. We sorted pictures of 3-D shapes that we find in our environments and played a "What's Missing" game with the 3-D objects that friends brought in from home. Then we made 2-D and 3-D shapes with toothpicks and marshmallows. We made patterns with cubes, played a pattern game on the smart board and sang and danced to a song about patterns. We made rainbows with Fruit Loops, marshmallows and pipe cleaners and some friends colored rainbow pictures. For our experiment this week we did the Skittles experiment. Everyone gave a hypothesis of what would happen if we poured warm water on skittles. Then we tested the hypotheses and everyone was correct: "the color came off", "the colors made a rainbow", "they streaked with colors and made colors". We also made beautiful name rainbows. Please check them out next time you come into the classroom. We played Ball Bingo and identified all the environmental print that everyone brought in. We read several great books: Bounce, Play Ball, Have a Ball, the Door Bell Rang and I'm worried. We continued to explore the feeling of worry in our resiliency lessons.

This week we ate a lot of fun food. We made Fruity Pebble treats. We ate Bugles for our cone shaped treat, cheese balls for our sphere treat, mini marshmallows for a cylinder treat and cheese squares for a cube treat.

This morning we attended a glow dance party with kindergarten in the media center.

The next two weeks, we will be doing fall fun learning activities and books. On October 31st, students may wear costumes or the color orange to school and we will have a fall party (more info to come). In November we will begin a new study, the Tree Study.
