We are having a great time as we continue to learn about trees. We explored trees and tree parts. We collected different leaves and made leaf rubbings and bark rubbings. We learned about deciduous trees and evergreen trees. We discovered lots of interesting things that grow on trees, like moss and fungi, and food that grows on trees, like fruit and nuts. We learned about the many different animals that live in or around trees and the types of homes they build there. We continue to work on phonemic awareness through poems and songs with rhyming words, counting word parts, and letter identification. We played the game Sparky to help us with our shapes, colors and taking turns.

Since our color days were interrupted by Red Ribbon/Bully Week, we are going to start our color days over: **M-Pink, T-white, TH-red, F-gray.** We will begin moving through the alphabet with a letter each day using our Handwriting Without Tears workbooks and other engaging activities.
