

Oak Ridge Elementary School Cafeteria Behavior Plan

The adults that supervise the lunchroom will monitor cafeteria behavior. Classes will have the opportunity to earn *Golden Eagles* for their positive behaviors displayed during lunchtime. The class in each grade level that earns the most *Golden Eagles* in a 9-week period will receive a classroom treat.

Students in grades 2-5 will eat their lunches and be required to read for the duration of their lunch period. At the end of each week, a reading activity (reader's theater, $Cofe\ OR$, Audio Books, etc.) will occur in the cafeteria to promote fun and exciting adventures in reading.

Cafeteria Guidelines for Success

- 1. Remain in your assigned seat unless you have permission to get up.
- 2. Use good table manners and eat only YOUR food.
- 3. Speak with soft voices and only to people at your table. Pay close attention to the Talk Light Colors:
 - = Continue talking at the same level
 - = Bring down the level of talking
 - = No talking the cafeteria
- 4. Leave your area clean by picking up all food or paper items before reading your book.
- 5. Read quietly to yourself until it is time to be dismissed.
- 6. Always walk in the cafeteria.
