## Volunteer Opportunities

### Baking/Refreshments

Volunteers prepare and send baked items, salads, and various refreshments (several times during the school year).

### Book Fair

Volunteers assist with Scholastic Books fundraiser Monday–Friday, Oct. 24 - 28 any time between 8:45am–4pm to help sell books, write receipts, restock and straighten books, and keep merchandise inside the designated area.

### Campus Cleanup

Help us beautify our campus at our fall and/or spring clean-up days! Volunteers wanting to do additional work may schedule time during the week or Saturdays (please indicate preference on attached form). Volunteers help weed, mulch, dig, plant, or pick up trash—plenty of manual labor to get some exercise for a good cause! Donations of landscape material or other items are also appreciated.

### Front Office

The school administration needs assistance in the front office this year for morning and afternoon shifts. This is a great way to see the school in action.

### Gold Card

Volunteers distribute treats once every 9 weeks to students with all 4's in citizenship and to students who have made all A's or brought up a letter grade. Volunteers also help with an end-of-year field trip, including lunch and ice cream, for Gold Card students.

### Grand-friends' Day

Raa invites grandparents or "grand-friends" to campus in November for breakfast in the Media Center with their grandchildren and individual student-guided tours of the campus. Volunteers provide breakfast items and small treats for the visitors and take photographs during the event.

### Pizza/Donut Sales

Volunteer to sell pizza from 3:40-4:10 p.m. and/or donuts from 8:30-9:20 a.m. one Friday/month.

### Partners for Excellence

Volunteer as a Partner for Excellence or work with the principal to help match partners to school needs. Parents, guardians, family members, friends, or employers can donate materials, services, or other support in the form of cash or in-kind donation.

### Raa Nights at Fun Station

Help with ticket sales and advertising for these fun nights at Fun Station. Students may use tickets on the organized Raa nights or any other convenient time. Tickets are also great for birthday gifts and stocking stuffers!

### SAC

The School Advisory Council meets monthly in the Media Center to develop the School Improvement Plan. Be involved and help make Raa a better school.

### School Fairs

This is part of Raa's performing arts program. Volunteers will be needed for ticket sales, setting up, preparing and serving the meal, and cleaning up afterwards. Proceeds will help to finance our fine arts programs at Raa.

### Teacher/Staff Appreciation

The PTO provides special treats to faculty and staff during Teacher Appreciation Week and they also

provide refreshments at monthly faculty meetings. Volunteers provide the treats and refreshments.

### Tutoring

Volunteers commit for the school year to tutor a student on a weekly basis who has been identified by his or her teacher as needing extra help. Dependable adult role models qualify for this program.

### 5th Grade Orientation

5<sup>th</sup> grade elementary students who will go to Raa next year attend a spring orientation at Raa and learn about its outstanding programs. Volunteers help coordinate, organize, and distribute goodie bags and snacks at this event.

### 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Dance

This is a dance for 8<sup>th</sup> graders on a Saturday in May. Parents and guardians of 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> graders are encouraged to volunteer (so 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents and guardians can relax and enjoy this milestone in their child's life) to help organize and decorate for the dance, and to chaperone the event.
