The Leon deadline for 2020 Summer/Fall Off-Campus Dual Enrollment Paperwork is April 17th for FSU, and May 13th for TCC, FAMU, and Lively Technical College.

Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate with a standard high school diploma, students must earn 24 credits and fulfill the following requirements as listed below:

- Cumulative 2.0 unweighted GPA
- Pass 10th Grade FSA ELA with a Level 3 or higher
- Pass Algebra I end-of-course assessment
- Successfully complete at least one on-line course (All of Leon High School’s Economics courses are blended and meet this requirement)
