Who is this for?

Any student behind in credits and needing to recover learning from previous courses where a D or F were earned.

Is there transportation?

Leon County Schools has arranged for bus transportation for the students attending who live in the Leon zone. (routes are TBA)

How do I sign up?

How do I know if my student qualifies?

You should have received an email inviting your student to attend the summer program if they did not receive credit for one or more of their core classes during the 1st semester.

However, any student who in previous high school courses failed to earn credit, may sign up as well. Please see your parent and/or

student portal for this information.

When is this program?

The program runs from June 13th until July 21st. During the weeks of June 27th and July 4th the program will be closed.

How does this work?

Students attend the summer program at Leon High School. They report on the above dates Monday -Thursday from 8:00 a.m. until noon each day.



What else do I need to know?

*Students will work on our online credit recovery platform at their own pace. Teachers will be in attendance to assist as needed. Students may work on their assignments from home, but will need to take assessments at school.

Are meals available?

Breakfast and lunch are available and FREE each day of the program. Breakfast begins at 7:00 a.m. and Lunch begins at noon.
