





GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- 24 CREDITS WITH ALL REQUIRED CORE CREDITS
- 2.0 UNWEIGHTED, CUMULATIVE GPA



NOTE:

- NO foreign language requirement for graduation
- NO community service requirement for graduation
- Online requirement was eliminated by the state this year!
- HOPE-PE credit or waiver required

COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

- If they haven't started already, they should ASAP!
- Transcripts
 - Uploaded as part of Common App
 - Email to have sent directly to school any other way
 - Email to get a copy printed for pick up to use for SSAR
- Letter's of Recommendation
 - HAVE A COPY OF YOUR <u>RESUME</u>, <u>LIST OF YOUR ACTIVITIES AND SCHOLASTIC RECORD</u> READY WHEN YOU ASK AN ADULT FOR A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION
 - ALLOW AT LEAST 2 WEEKS TO MEET A DEADLINE
 - INFORM COUNSELOR/TEACHER TO LOOK FOR AN EMAIL
- FSU's deadline for FL students is October 15th

ACT and/or SAT

Occilized CollegeBoard

 Students sign up on their own and select a convenient test location and date!

Either an ACT or SAT score is:

- Required for applications to a four year university
- Required for Bright Futures
- NOT required for admission to TCC

Bright Futures

- Application is required students should apply no matter what!
- Community service hours are required
 - must be documented by the student and submitted via email to their counselor by graduation





DRESS CODE FOR GRADUATION

- Dress whose length does not extend beneath the hem of the gown
- Dress shoes....no flip flops or boots
 - You need to be confident about walking in your shoes.
- If you choose to wear hosiery, select a tone which closely matches skin color.

- Dark or khaki dress slacks
- WHITE dress shirt and a tie
- Dress shoes no athletic shoes, hunting boots or combat boots.
 - Shoes should be freshly cleaned/polished and worn with dark dress socks.

- No adornments (flowers, medallions, jewelry) are worn on/with the caps and gowns with the exception of Leon High School issued honor cords and Pierian honor stoles.
- Monogrammed caps or gowns will NOT be permitted into the Civic Center.
