Assessment Limits: Items must ask about the text version and its multimedia counterpart. The item's difficulty may be dependent on the significance and extent of the adaptation's departure from the original text. Items may focus on the effectiveness of the adaptation. Items may ask students to analyze the purpose of a decision to present the information in diverse media. Items may ask students to evaluate the motives behind the presentation of the content in a particular media format. Written transcripts, excerpts, and/or direct quotations from an audio clip should not be provided in item stems or answer options.
