Camp Descriptions

Adventures in Art – An arts & crafts extravaganza! Come for drawing, painting, sculpting, graphic arts, comic art, & so much more! Exercise your creativity!!!

Brain Games – Exercise Your Brain! Test Your Smarts! Compete and Win! Join us for games that make you think. Activities may include: Scrabble, Chess, Boggle, Farkle, Head-Bands, mastermind, Connect 4, memory games, team quiz bowls, and much, much more. Are you up for the challenge?

Cheer Camp – B-U-C-K-S – Let's Go Bucks! Join us this summer to expand on your cheer knowledge, improve skills, and familiarize yourself with proper cheer techniques. Beneficial for those who may try out for the upcoming school year. No experience required.

Christmas in July - Are you like Buddy the Elf? Does the thought of Christmas make you scream with joy? This week will be full of festive fun. Campers will make take-home crafts, bake treats and enjoy the tastes of frozen hot chocolate on a summer's day. Since it's too warm for snow, there's a possible forecast of shaved ice for all.

Cooking Wars – Tie-on your aprons and let the wars begin!! While learning basic cooking and baking skills throughout the week, your child will showcase their creativity as they prepare themed meals for judging each day. Campers will also learn about making healthy choices in meal preparation. At the end of the week, they will even participate in Cupcake Wars!

Dance Camp – come learn a fun new dance as we perfect technique and choreography!

Dungeons & Dragons - The camp will offer students the opportunity to learn and play the Tabletop Role Playing Game of Dungeons and Dragons. Dungeons and Dragons is a cooperative, creative, and fun game to learn and play! The game teaches kids how to communicate, make decisions, and how to problem solve! Mr. George will design and create stories and environments for students to create their own characters to interact and play in.

Fiesta Time, Amigos! - Interested in learning about Central and South American cultures? Grab your passport and join us as we travel this week through different Latin countries learning their different customs and culture. Campers will learn about Latin American music and dances, as well as cook and taste different favorite recipes.

Gaming with Ollie: Take yourself back in time playing vintage board games. Prizes will be given, and Ollie will be there to cheer you on! Activities may include: Spirographs, Clue, Sorry, Monopoly, Connect 4, and many more. Come have fun and give your brain a break from electronics.

Gardening Galore - Not sure if you have a green thumb? Connect with nature and other campers in our school gardens. Campers will spend their week immersed in the delights of a working garden. They will connect with the plants, learn to cook and eat from the garden, and create a DIY succulent turtle or jellyfish.

Math Academy – Campers will be given the opportunity to have an individual study of Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, and Geometry in a relaxed atmosphere with friends or work with the math competition group. This camp is geared towards students going into grades 6-9 who would like to get ahead for their next math class or prepare for math competitions. Camp instruction will given by Deerlake's award-winning certified math teachers!

MS Orientation (6th Grade) – Are you ready to Escape into the Sixth Grade?? To ensure you are prepared, come to orientation camp! We will get you ready for multi-classes & teachers, navigating the 6th grade CANVAS platform, review responsible digital citizenship and introduce you to the 6th grade teachers. During this camp, you have a chance to meet new classmates and develop new friendships, while participating in games and campus scavenger hunts. The end of the week *Escape Room* is a MUST DO for all upcoming 6th graders!!

Movie & Film Camp - This camp will feature movies and films that were and are influential in the history of Movie and Film. This will teach students certain aspects of film like story, character development, and cinematography!

MVP Sports Zone – This camp is an all-sports camp that is perfect for the athlete who enjoys a variety of sports and recreational games. Campers are taught skills and given the opportunity to compete in a variety of sports such as soccer, basketball, flag football, pickleball, and more, while also enjoying some favorite recreational games. It's a great way for students to not only meet our DMS coaches, but enjoy high paced, non-stop fun during the summer! Not only will students be exposed to various sports and skills, but the week will also be filled with the emphasis on sportsmanship, playing with character, and intentional small group.

Orchestra Rising Strings Camp – Rising sixth graders who are interested in playing violin, viola, cello, or string bass will play in an orchestra, attend sectionals, have guided practice time, and participate in a performance at the end of the session.

Seas the Day - Do you like the beach, arts and crafts? The weather is warming up, and it's no better time than to *Seas the Day!* Campers will get to work with repurposed beach materials – seashells, sea glass, sand -- to create numerous beach-themed crafts.

SWITCHin' It Up – Are you ready to SWITCH it up?! Join our middle school eSports summer camp and take your gaming skills to the next level! Our program offers a supportive and fun environment for students who love gaming and want to have a friendly competition with their friends! Campers will have the chance to explore different games like Mario Kart, Smash Brothers and other SWITCH platform games. We will also focus on improving individual skills, teamwork, communication and sportsmanship. Our final day we will put our skills to the test as we host competitive tournaments and scrimmages. Join us in Deerlake's First eSports Camp . . . stretch out, charge up!

Volleyball – Athletes will focus on growing the basic volleyball skills of: passing, setting, hitting, and serving. These skills will be enhanced by many different drills, interactive games, and competitions. This camp is designed for all girls who may be interested in trying out for a volleyball team.

Upcycled Creations - Ever wonder if something old can be reused? Like to explore and challenge yourself creatively? Then join us as we take something used and make something new. Campers will have an opportunity to experiment with and create new things with repurposed items. We will create garden planters, wind chimes, and other DIY projects using upcycled materials.

Vex Robotics Camp (Half & Full Day Option) - Campers will build VEX EXP Basebots, then program on VEXcode to complete a Challenge! Afterward, campers will explore how to add and use sensors so their robot can find and push items, no matter the location. This will be a busy, hands-on camp with students taking on the rolls of designers, computer scientists, and creative thinkers- all while having fun exploring STEM concepts. This camp is appropriate for rising 6th thru 8th graders.

Vex Robotics Camp (Full Day) - This camp will be appropriate for both new and returning campers. We will build VEX EXP Basebots then add manipulators to complete various challenges. The use of sensors, motors, and VexCode will be extended. This will be a busy, hands-on camp with students taking on the rolls of designers, computer scientists, and creative thinkers!

Video Production – Campers will produce, direct, light, shoot, and edit as they make their own movies. Campers will learn to utilize titles, graphics, music, and live-action video. Throughout the week, campers will develop leadership, communication, project management, creative design and technical skills.
