Credit for Graduation: 1.0 Credit – Elective CTE credit

Pre-requisite: Desire to develop self-awareness and employability skills.

Description:

The purpose of this course is to provide students with an opportunity to experience success in school and improve attitudes and behaviors towards learning, self, school and community. Through enrollment in this class, students are connected with public and private health, employment, counseling and social services. The private sector is involved in the collaboration in a variety of ways. Institutions of higher education also join the partnership by providing interns, tutors, mentors and scholarships.
