Description:

2D/3D Art Levels 1, 2, 3

Students experiment with a variety of fiber techniques used to create 2-D & 3D fiber pieces. They will develop, practice and refine skills in knitting, crocheting, sewing, weaving, spinning, dyeing, screen printing and other fiber mediums. Students will practice their skills to work towards a larger project using skills learned. Through the critique process, students evaluate and respond to their own work and that of their peers. This is an active class where students have the opportunity to explore artistically, regardless of their current skills. All levels are welcome and equally catered to. Main goal is that students find some type of personal enjoyment and creative expression in the art-making process.

Expectations:

Art production in variety of fiber mediums.

Respectful approach to supplies, equipment, teachers, peers.

Periodic group discussion related to content.

Periodic writing activities related to content.

Group critique/evaluation participation.

Openness to trying new things and willingness to make mistakes and fail.
