- Students will learn new concepts and techniques of choral singing, and apply them to the repertoire of the SAIL Chorus during rehearsals and performances
- Each student will take responsibility for the maintenance of their own chorus folder
- Students will participate in the end of semester performance
- Students will participate in discussions and written work in class
