
## SEVEN STEPS TO BEING SUCCESSFUL IN 5TH GRADE

#### **Brick and Mortar and Digital Academy Attendance Policy**

Dear Parents,

Attendance for both Brick and Mortar and Digital Academy will be taken every day. Our Brick and Mortar student's attendance will be taken as normal. Elementary teachers will be taking attendance each morning and Middle School teachers will be taking attendance at the beginning of each period.

If your student will be at home learning through our Digital Academy, it is encouraged that your student log on during their scheduled time for real time learning by their teacher(s). Teachers will have a log when your students log on, the time they logged on, and the amount of time spent on the Canvas for the day. Your student's teachers will then take attendance according to that log. If your student does not sign in to Canvas during a school day, they will be marked absent by 4:15PM, which is the end of the school day.

For our Digital Academy students, please communicate with the school if there was a situation that prevented your student from logging on during the school day.

## Breakfast, Lunch and Transitional procedures

### **Breakfast Procedures:**

- 1. Students will start to arrive at your door at 7:50 a.m.

### **Elementary Transitions**

# Types of face coverings

Types of face coverings can include a cloth mask or medical-grade masks (e.g., surgical face masks, N95 respirators). A face covering must cover the nose and mouth completely. Any mask that incorporates a valve that is designed to facilitate easy exhaling, mesh masks, or masks with openings, holes, visible gaps in the design or material, or vents are not sufficient face coverings because they allow droplets to be released from the mask.

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
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
