Maps are flat. Maps and globes help us find places on Earth. North America is our continent. A continent is a large area of land.




Did you know there is more water on Earth than land? Oceans, rivers and lakes are larger bodies of water. Ponds and creeks are smaller bodies of water. Many people like to swim or fish or sail.



There are many different kinds of land on Earth. A mountain is a very tall piece of land that sticks up from the Earth. A valley is the land between two mountains. A desert is a very dry area where not many plants can grow. A beach is a sandy piece of land near a large body of water.

This is a compass rose. It shows north, south, east and west. We use a compass rose to show directions on a map. Color the compass rose.







Florida is famous for its beaches. People come from all over the world to swim, surf and play at the beaches in Florida.

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
