# Day in the Life of a Montford Mustang

The following scenarios will provide a description of what students can expect when school resumes on August 31, 2020. **\*There are many changes to the previous school routines.** Please review these changes with your student. Additionally, please note that students will not be allowed to congregate during the day or in any area before and after school.

Per Florida Statute 1003.21, all students must be present and accounted for each period of the day, including digital students.

Morning Intake – 9:15AM – 9:30AM	Important Program Notes
<ul> <li>Students should arrive on campus no earlier than 9:15 AM. Supervision will begin at 8:45 AM, however, we ask all parents to not drop off, let their students walk, or let them ride their bicycles to school before 9:15 AM.</li> <li>Once students arrive on campus, they will immediately proceed to through the gates at the front of campus to receive a health screening. After being screened, 6<sup>th</sup> graders will report to the tennis courts. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will report to the soccer fields.</li> </ul>	<ol> <li>Digital students must be present for attendance each period of the day per the Florida compulsory school attendance law, F.S.1003.21.</li> <li>Participation in the Digital Academy is different than a Virtual School experience. Digital students keep the same learning pace and assignment production as those in the Brick and Mortar building. Virtual School is a self- directed completion rate.</li> <li>Students will be expected to complete assignments as determined by the teacher.</li> </ol>
Students will wear masks according to school and/or district policy guidelines and may not remove them without permission from a teacher on supervision duty. Even while outside, if students are not six feet apart, they must wear a mask.	<ul> <li>4. We recommend each student complete a device and connectivity check each morning by 9:15AM to ensure they are ready to log in to their classes by 9:30AM.</li> <li>5. Teacher office hours are 8:30AM – 4:00PM, Monday – Friday. See Teacher for specific availability</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Block 1 - 9:30AM - 11:15AM</li> <li>Students will remain in this class until 11:15AM</li> <li>Students will wear masks according to teacher's classroom rules and/or district policy guidelines and may not remove them without teacher permission.</li> <li>For the safety of all, students should not expect to move around the classroom without the explicit direction from the teacher.</li> <li>Students may receive mask breaks as determined by the teacher's schedule</li> <li>Students will have 5 minutes to transition to 2<sup>nd</sup> assigned class for the day.</li> <li>Masks must be worn in the hallway.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Block 1 - 9:30AM - 11:15AM</li> <li>At 9:30AM students will log onto class through Teams or Zoom, as directed by the teacher.</li> <li>Teacher will record attendance and answer student questions. Digital students must be present each day, each period for attendance, per LCS rule and state compulsory school attendance statute.</li> <li>Once class begins, students will have one of the following options as determined by their teacher: <ul> <li>a) Remain with the class for live instruction, or</li> <li>b) Listen/watch a previously recorded lesson</li> </ul> </li> <li>Students will work on assignments at any time during the class as determined by the teacher</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Block 2 - 11:20AM – 1:30PM</li> <li>Students will remain in this class until 1:30 PM</li> <li>Students will wear masks according to teacher's classroom rules and/or district policy guidelines and may not remove them without teacher permission.</li> <li>Students will have a 25-minute lunch with 5 minutes transition there and back. Only bagged lunches will be served from the cafeteria.</li> <li>At lunch students will either sit inside social distanced by 6 feet from all students, or they can sit outside with 2 students per one picnic table, and each table will be 8 feet from the other tables</li> <li>Masks must be worn at lunch unless eating</li> <li>All students will have 5 minutes to</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Block 2 - 11:20AM - 1:30PM</li> <li>At 11:20AM students will log onto class through Teams or Zoom</li> <li>Teacher will record attendance and answer student questions. Digital students must be present each day, each period for attendance, per LCS rule and state compulsory school attendance law, F.S.1003.21.</li> <li>Once class begins, students will have one of the following options as determined by their teacher: <ul> <li>a) Remain with the class for live instruction, or</li> <li>b) Listen/watch a previously recorded lesson</li> <li>Students will work on assignments at any time during the class as determined by the teacher</li> <li>Students may be called back to live</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

### Block 3 – 1:35 PM – 3:20PM

- Students will remain in this class until 3:20 pm
- Students will wear masks according to teacher's classroom rules and/or district policy guidelines and may not remove them without teacher permission.
- For the safety of all, students should not expect to move around the classroom without the explicit direction from the teacher.

Students may receive mask breaks as determined by the teacher's schedule

### Homeroom – 3:20-3:50

 Students will not transition to a new Homeroom, but will either stay in 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> period, depending on the day, to participate in Homeroom activities. Some of these activities are required by state law, such as Mental Health and Anti-bullying training while other activities will be academic in nature.

### Block 3 - 1:35PM - 3:20 PM

- At 1:35PM students will log onto class through Teams or Zoom.
- Teacher will record attendance and answer student questions. Digital students must be present each day, each period for attendance, per LCS rule and state compulsory school attendance law, F.S.1003.21.
- Once class begins, students will have one of the following options as determined by their teacher:
  - a) Remain with the class for live instruction, or
  - b) Listen/watch a previously recorded lesson
- Students will work on assignments at any time during the class as determined by the teacher
- Students may be called back to live session by teacher according to the lesson plan

#### Homeroom – 3:20-3:50

 Students will be required to log back in at 3:20pm into their Block 3 class. There are Homeroom activities which sometimes will be mandatory, even for digital students, such as Mental Health and Anti-bullying training.

There will be some days the activities will be more academic in nature.

<ul> <li>Students will be dismissed at 3:50PM.</li> <li>Students should reach their bus within 5 minutes</li> <li>Students will wear masks at all times during dismissal on the bus ramp, at the parent pick-up sidewalk and on the bus ride home.</li> <li>There will be no congregating during the day at school or in any areas before, during, or after school</li> </ul>	<ol> <li>Students should complete their assignments on time as directed by their teacher.</li> <li>Recorded lessons can be viewed multiple times for further support.</li> <li>All completed assignments should be the student's own work.</li> <li>Teachers are available during office hours for additional help between 8:30AM and 4:00PM. Please refer to their teaching schedule if you are trying to reach them.</li> </ol>
