WHAT IS TITLE I?

Title I, Part A, provides resources that help children gain a high-quality education and the skills to master the Florida Standards. Title I provides additional resources to schools with economically disadvantaged students. These resources may provide additional teachers, academic materials, professional development, parent workshops, and other activities designed to raise student achievement. The Leon County School District implements a schoolwide model providing schools with greater needs access to services for all students.

BACKPACK FAIRY

More than 945 backpacks were donated to the Title I Office for schools for the 2024-2025 school year!

PREPARING FOR BACK TO SCHOOL? FIVE TIPS FOR PARENTS

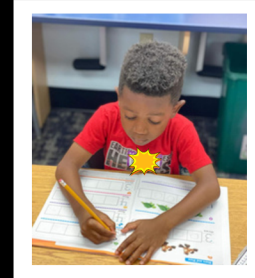
As we enter the back-to-school season, parents may be curious about how their children are feeling about going back to school. Some students have mixed emotions – feeling hesitant about losing their free time but looking forward to seeing friends and learning new things. It is crucial for parents to help their children have a positive school experience. Below are five (5) tips that can assist in supporting your child to succeed this year:

- Set a positive example by demonstrating enthusiasm for education and the learning process. Begin early and maintain a positive attitude towards school to encourage a love of learning in your child.
- Stay connected with your child's teacher and school community by participating in volunteer opportunities, attending parent and family engagement workshops, or staying up to date through newsletters and emails. Show respect and speak highly of your child's teachers to foster a positive relationship.
- Address any anxiety your child may have about school by offering reassurance and support. Promote open communication about their feelings and assist them in developing coping strategies.
- Be prepared to problem solve if your child encounters academic challenges. Seek outside support such as tutoring if necessary and be open to considering changes that may benefit your child's learning environment.
- Stay engaged with your child's school experience by asking about homework, classroom activities, and how you can support learning at home. Effective communication and encouragement are vital for a successful school year.
