GRADUATION CEREMONY BEHAVIOR PLEDGE**

The following are guidelines for the convocation and graduation ceremonies

Attire: Black dress (that does not show below the gown) or black pants with white collared shirt and a dark colored tie. Black dress shoes/dress socks; if heels are worn – strap or covered heel is strongly encouraged. Guests are expected to dress in a manner that is appropriate to the dignity of the occasion, such as business attire. Please address senior sponsors with questions/concerns.

Prohibited Items: Any items that can be used to disrupt the dignity of the occasion will not be allowed in the Civic Center. For example, noisemakers, signs, beach balls, or any other object that causes a distraction will not be allowed.

Behavior: Students will be required to follow all instructions that are given to them by the senior sponsors and Principal Burch. Guests are required to behave in a dignified manner. For example, when the name of each graduate is called, brief applause is appropriate. However, yelling or other conduct that will interfere with the next name being heard is not appropriate.

Guests of Parents: Parents are responsible for the conduct of their invited guests and are expected to review these behavior guidelines with each guest before the ceremony.
