DRESS CODE

In order to maintain a respectful atmosphere, students at Roberts Elementary should dress comfortably and modestly. Dress code guidelines are as follows:

• Tennis shoes are recommended. Open-toed, platform, and backless shoes are discouraged. Students should wear tennis shoes to school on P.E. days.

- Clothing must cover the chest, back and mid-section; no spaghetti strap or strapless shirts.
- Pants must be worn at the waistline no sagging.
- Undergarments must not be exposed at any time.
- Attire and jewelry must not depict drugs, tobacco or alcoholic beverages.

• Hats, bedroom clothes and slippers are not allowed on campus unless a special day or event has been designated.

SCHOOL DAY

Roberts' school day is from 8:30 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. Please schedule activities around these hours.

LATE ARRIVAL PROCEDURES (after 8:30)

The first bell rings at 8:20 am and instruction starts right away. Students arriving at 8:30 must be escorted to the office by their parent/guardian where they will sign in and receive a tardy pass to class.

LEON COUNTY SCHOOL BUS RULES

- 1. Obey the driver.
- 2. Stay seated and face the front.
- 3. Talk quietly never yell!
- 4. Keep your hands, arms, feet, and objects to yourself.
- 5. Do not use bad language, put downs, or "racial slurs".
- 6. Remain orderly while waiting for the bus.
- 7. Wait until it is your turn to load and unload.
- 8. Do not eat on the bus.

The bus driver is in charge. If you break the rules, he/she will give you a warning or bus referral.

GENERAL PLAYGROUND RULES

- Use the playground equipment only with the permission of the adult in charge.
- Walk to the playground area, do not run.
- Do not do windmills on the climbing bars.
- Climb the equipment carefully.
- Do not push or pull others.
- Do not jump from play equipment and swings.
- Tag and running is NOT permitted on the mulch.
- Only one student should be on a slide at a time.
- Slide down feet first, never head first.
- Do not stand up on the slide.
