### Be sure to keep up with your FSA ID and password!

- It is highly recommended that you use the IRS Tax Return Transcript import feature to add your information and/or parent tax information.
- If you don't use the IRS import tool, you will be required to provide an Official 2020 Tax Return Transcript or Non-filing Letter AND W2's from the IRS for you and/or your parents Tax Return Transcript(s) (see our verification flyer).
- Once your FAFSA has been successfully submitted, it will take 4-7 days to process.
- You will receive an email stating that you have a SAR (Student Aid Report). Log into to FAFSA account and check your SAR for errors and/or required verifications.
- You must bring all verification documents for you and/or your parents to the Office of Financial Aid prior to completing your registration process. Verification packets are available on the Lively Technical College Financial Aid website, visit www.livelytech.com.
