## **STANDARDS AND EXPECTATIONS**

In order to remain in the Fairview IB Prep Magnet Program, students must:

- Demonstrate a high degree of motivation and interest toward excellence in academics;
- Practice exemplary self-discipline and academic maturity;
- Conform to behavior standards set forth by the Leon County Schools and Fairview Middle School;
- Understand that grade point averages below a 2/5 or a D grade in any class, or unacceptable behavior, results in probationary status and/or dismissal from the magnet program if not corrected in a timely manner, at the discretion of the IB Prep administrator and faculty/staff;
- Complete the Community Service requirement.

## **MINIMUM CRITERIA**

- Complete application with all ancillary material. (2021-2022 FSA Scores, Winter FAST scores, writing sample, honor code, teacher reference form, most recent report card.)
- Complete Leon County School Choice request form. (This form will only be utilized if the student is accepted into the FMS Magnet program; otherwise, it will be considered null and void.)

## **APPLICATION PART II: ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED**

The following documents are required and must be submitted as part of a student's application. Applications cannot be reviewed for admission until all documentation has been submitted.

- FSA Scores (2021-2022 school year)
- FAST Scores (December/January scores for 2022-2023)
- Reference from a CORE academic teacher (enclosed) - the teacher should submit this directly to Ms. Thompson - this can be emailed to thompsonc1@leonschools.net with the child's name in the subject area. It can also be send via interoffice mail. Due: March 31, 2023.
- Honor Code agreement signed by parent and student should be included.

Each student is required to submit a writing sample. Please choose one of the two topics listed below, write one paragraph answering the prompt. This can be typed or hand written.

1. Write a paragraph that informs your audience of what traits great leaders have.
2. Write a paragraph that argues whether or not middle school students should be allowed to use cell phones while at school.

## IB PREP MAGNET PROGRAM HONOR CODE
