How Much Will the Trip Cost?

Total cost of <u>\$1,340.00</u> includes:

- Transportation cost <u>\$380.00</u>
- Hotels (with security) <u>\$231.18</u>
- Meals <u>\$360.00</u>
- Tickets and Activities \$323.76
- Trip supplies (e.g., t-shirts, etc.) \$45.60

Trip payments break down:

- Deposit of \$335 on September 29th (non-refundable)
- 2nd payment of \$335 on October 31st
- 3rd payment of \$335 on Tuesday, November 30th
- 4th payment of \$335 on Tuesday, January 31st

When and How to Pay?



Payments will be made through the eFunds for Schools System. Information about how to create an account and pay through eFunds will be sent with Trip Information Letter.



Families may begin to make payments **Friday, September 29**, **2023.**



Students must submit their district Activity Form and DC/NYC Trip Behavior Contract the day deposit payment is made *(will be distributed before deposit payment due).*


Academic Expectations

Must maintain a D - or better in ALL courses on the 2nd Nine-Weeks report card and 3rd Nine Weeks progress report.

Failure to maintain a D - or better on progress reports (2nd and 3rd Nine Weeks) will result in trip probation.

Trip probation means: *The student MUST improve the failing grade, or risk being removed.*

Administration will weigh special circumstances.



Behavior Expectations

Behavior Contract Highlights:

- Any student who receives
 - One (1) Out-of-School Suspension (OSS) referral or
 - Two (2) Opportunity to Improve (OFI) referrals during the 2nd and 3rd Nine Weeks will be ineligible to attend.

During activities, students:

- Must follow all rules and directions of any RMS chaperone during the event.
- Must comply with any given direction the first time it is given.
- Must follow all RMS rules, dress code, and student handbook expectations apply during each activity.
 - Attire must be appropriate.
