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French 1 & 2 (Elementary French)	In these beginning French courses, students learn the basics of French grammar, vocabulary, and francophone culture. These two courses satisfy the world language requirement in order to apply to a four year university in Florida and are open to all grade levels.
French 3 (Intermediate French)	This course is for students who wish to continue their study of French at a more advanced level or who are preparing to enter the IB program. Focus is placed on more complex grammatical structures, and students further develop their receptive and productive skills in French.
French 4 (IB Year 1)	This course is for students who have successfully completed three years of Pre-IB coursework in French. French 4 is the first year of the Language B program, during which students are introduced to the IB curriculum, the required course themes, and begin preparation for the Language B exam the following year.
French 5 (IB Year 2)	French 5 corresponds to the second year of the Language B program at the Standard Level (SL) . At the end of this course, students will be assessed on their abilities in speaking, listening, writing, and reading French at an advanced level.
French 6 (IB Year 2)	French 6 corresponds to the second year of the Language B program at the Higher Level (HL) . At the end of this course, students will be assessed on their abilities in speaking, listening, writing, and reading French at an advanced level. Students who elect HL French will be required to study two literary works in preparation for the Language B exam.
