Block 1 - 7:30 AM - 9:15 AM

- Students will remain in this class until
 9:15 AM
- Students will wear masks according to teacher's classroom rules and/or district policy guidelines. Masks cannot be removed without teacher permission.
- Students may receive mask breaks as determined by the teacher's schedule.
- For the safety of all, students should not expect to move around the classroom without the explicit direction from the teacher.
- Students will have 5 minutes to transition to 2nd assigned class/Block

- Masks must be worn during all hallway transitions.

Block 1 - 7:30 AM - 9:15 AM

- At 7:30 AM students will log on CANVAS via Class link.
- Teachers will record attendance and answer student questions. Digital students must be present each day, each period for attendance, per LCS rule and state compulsory school attendance statute.
- Once class begins, students will have one of the following options as determined by their teacher:
 - a) Remain with the class for live instruction, or
 - b) Listen/watch a previously recorded lesson
- Students will work on assignments at any time during the class as determined by the teacher.
- Students may be called back to live session by teacher, according to the lesson plan.

Block 2 - 9:20 AM - 11:50 AM

- All students will attend class from 9:20 AM to 10:05 AM. Students will wear masks according to the teacher's classroom rules and/or district policy guidelines. Masks cannot be removed without teacher permission.
- Students assigned to Lunch A will eat from 10:05 AM – 10:45 AM (40minutes). Only bagged lunches will be served from the cafeteria. Lunch A students will have 5 minutes to return for the second part of class from 10:50 AM to 11:50 PM.
- Students assigned to Lunch B will remain in class from 9:20 AM – 11:10 AM. These students will eat from 11:10 AM -11:50 AM (40-minutes).
- At lunch students will either sit inside social distanced by 6 feet from all students, or they can sit outside with 4 students per one picnic table, and each table will be 8 feet from the other tables
- Masks must be worn at lunch unless consuming food or drink.
- Students will have 5 minutes to transition to their Block 3 class.

Block 2 - 9:20 AM - 11:50 PM

- At 9:20 AM students will log on CANVAS via Class link.
- Teacher will record attendance and answer student questions. Digital students must be present each day, each period for attendance, per LCS rule and state compulsory school attendance law, F.S.1003.21.
- Once class begins, students will have one of the following options as determined by their teacher:
 - a) Remain with the class for live instruction, or
 - b) Listen/watch a previously recorded lesson
- Students will work on assignments at any time during the class as determined by the teacher.
- Students may be called back to live session by teacher according to the lesson plan.

 1:40 PM
- Students will wear masks according to teacher's classroom rules and/or district policy guidelines. Masks cannot be removed without teacher permission.
- For the safety of all, students should not expect to move around the classroom without the consent from the teacher.

Students may receive mask breaks as determined by the teacher's schedule.

Block 3 - 11:55 AM - 1:40 PM

- At 11:55 AM students will log on CANVAS via Class link
- Teachers will record attendance and answer student questions. Digital Academy students must be present each day, each period for attendance, per LCS rule and state compulsory school attendance law, F.S.1003.21.
- Once class begins, students will have one of the following options as determined by their teacher:
 - a) Remain with the class for live instruction, or
 - b) Listen/watch a previously recorded lesson
- Students will work on assignments at any time during the class, as determined by the teacher.
- Students may be called back to live session by teacher, according to the lesson plan.

Dismissal

- Students who ride the bus should make their way to the bus area when the 1:40 PM dismissal bell sounds.
 Buses routinely exit campus 5 minutes after dismissal.
- Students will wear masks at all times during dismissal and while on the school bus.
- Students who walk home should exit campus directly after the 1:40 PM dismissal bell sounds.
- Car riders should wear masks and properly social distance while waiting to be picked up. Car riders assemble at the front of the school. Car Riders should be picked up by 2:20 PM.

Important Program Notes

- Students should complete their assignments on time as directed by their teacher.
- Recorded lessons can be viewed multiple times for further support.
- All completed assignments should be the student's own work.
- Teachers are available during office hours for additional academic support between 7:00 AM and 2:30 PM.
 Please refer to their teaching schedule if you are trying to reach them.

Lockers <u>will not</u> be assigned or used during the 2020-2021 school year. Lockers rooms will also not be used at least through the first semester. Students assigned to physical education, team sports or weight training **will not** be required to dress out.
