



Families with students in Leon County Public Schools may qualify for the INTERNET FOR ALL Program if they participate in a qualifying program or have a gross household income at or below 185 percent of the federal poverty guidelines.

Automatically Qualify if Receiving:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- National School Lunch Program
- > Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Veterans and Survivors Pension Benefit

INTERNET FOR ALL provides free internet service to families that qualify. Depending on their address, they will receive either:

- 1. Internet Essentials from Xfinity (Comcast)
- 2. T-Mobile Hot Spot
