Summer Camp Program Policy and Procedures

Registration

There is a one-time registration fee of \$45.00. (Includes camp shirt) \$10.00. This fee is non-refundable and is required at the time you submit your registration forms. This fee will secure a slot for your child(ren) in our summer camp program. Please bring in your registration forms and payment to Hartsfield Elementary School April 8th-May 5th between the hours of 11:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. If your child(ren) attends any Leon County schools, you can also make payments online through the focus portal.

Early Learning Coalition participants please see the Director for registration.

Enrollment Eligibility

Summer camp participants are rising Kindergarteners through rising sixth graders. Kindergarteners must meet basic entry-level criteria in all areas of self-care, communication, mobility, and social-emotional development. All participants must complete the Summer Camp registration form prior to participation in the program. For returning campers, if there's a balance owed to the program, it MUST be cleared before registering for summer camp.

❖ Arrival & Departure

For the safety and well-being of all participants, a parent or guardian must sign each child out every day. Children will only be released to authorized persons by the custodial parent. All siblings must be at least 18 years of age to pick up.

Camp Location

Summer Camp will be housed at Hartsfield Elementary School located at 1414 Chowkeebin NeNe Tallahassee, Florida 32301.

- The Main Office is CLOSED on Fridays during the summer
- June 19th, camp will be closed to observe Juneteenth
- Summer Camp is CLOSED July 1-5 for Independence Day holiday

Payment of Fees

Camp fees are to be paid weekly to participate in the program.

♦ A <u>Late fee of \$10.00</u> will be assessed for fees not paid on or before the start of the next week of camp. Fees can be paid by debit/credit cards on Hartfield's webpage. Make money orders payable to Leon County Schools. No Cash is accepted. Payments are due on Mondays of each week. If no payment is made by Monday campers will not be able to attend!

Money Orders must be signed and include your child's name.

Refunds are not given except for cases of prolonged illness (two weeks or longer) or family relocation. Parent must request the refund in writing.

Parents are advised to keep their original receipts.


If you need to cancel your child's attendance for summer camp, please notify the director as soon as possible. If your child misses a day, you are still responsible for the camp fee.

Late Pick-up Fees

Summer camp ends at 6:00 P.M. Parents who are late picking up their child will be assessed a late fee. Parents will be charged a late fee of \$1.00 per minute beginning at 6:01p.m. After two non-emergency late fees, the director will notify the parents that a third non-emergency late fee could result in dismissal from the program.

Lunch & Snacks

Breakfast & Lunch will be provided daily. This year we're offering sack lunches which will include peanut butter and jelly, cold deli sandwiches, etc. If you have a picky eater, packing them a lunch or extra snacks is highly recommended. If children are staying for an extended time, packing an extra snack is also highly recommended. We do not provide snack during camp!





❖ Discipline- PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!

The Summer Camp program staff will utilize positive discipline practices to achieve our goal of providing quality programs for children in an environment of cooperation and respect. These policies and practices are consistent and conform to our school's behavior support plan which includes conscious discipline expectations and the Leon County School's Student Code of Conduct. If inappropriate behaviors continue after reminders of the expectations have been given, the child's parents will be asked to join in a conference with the EDEP manager. If a child chooses not to demonstrate appropriate behavior within the program, there may be a recommendation made to dismiss the child from the program. If the child is dismissed from the program, no refund will be given.

Disciplinary Procedures

To achieve the goal of providing quality enrichment programs for children in an environment of cooperation and respect, staff members utilizes conscious discipline protocol and positive discipline practices.

Program Ruies

- Respect yourself, others, and property.
- Always follow directions.
- Walk and use quiet voices.
- Speak kindly to others.
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.

Formal Consequences

- 1st Offense Verbal Warning and Loss of Privileges
- 2nd Offense Note Home to Parent and Parent Conference
- 3rd Offense 3-Day Suspension
- Any offense thereafter could result in dismissal from the program.

Parents will always be notified when formal consequences are applied. NOTE: Any violence towards students or staff members will result in <u>immediate dismissal from program</u>. The director reserves the right to bypass any step in the discipline policy depending upon the severity of the situation/incident.

Insurance

Summer Camp does not carry accident insurance on participants. It is the parent's responsibility to carry adequate accidental insurance. Accident insurance is available through Leon County Schools. Check with the school secretary for an application.

Iliness

Children who are ill (fever, cough, vomiting, etc.) during the Summer Camp Program will sit out until a parent or guardian has been notified. Students must be picked up by a parent/guardian depending on the severity of illness.

Medication

Doctor prescribed medication will be administered according to the label. Children are not allowed to transport medication. Should your child need to have medication administered during the time they are in the Summer Camp Program, a medication form must be completed. The medication must be in its original container and must be taken during the hours your child is in attendance at the time and dosage level prescribed by the doctor.
