CREDIT:

Half a credit (.50) is awarded per semester per class with a grade of a D or better.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA):

The unweighted GPA is calculated on a 4.0 scale. The weighted GPA is calculated using the 4.0 scale, plus an additional quality point is awarded for a grade of a C or higher in Advanced Placement or Dual Enrollment classes, and .5 quality point is awarded for a grade of C or higher in Honors classes.

CLASS RANK:

Rank is calculated by using the weighted GPA in all coursework. Rank is recalculated at the end of each semester
