What do we learn?



RULES

expectations

1. **Be prompt**- Be in your seat, working, when the bell rings.
2. **Be prepared**- Bring all required materials to class every day. Make sure to ask to borrow writing utensils **BEFORE** class starts.
3. **Be productive**- Actively participate in class. You have a 10-pt participation grade every week. Absences don't count against you.
4. **Be patient**- Raise your hand and wait to be called on by me. Only one person will speak at a time when we have discussions.
5. **Be polite**- Be respectful of others' property, time, opinions, and effort. Follow directions the **FIRST** time they are given.

TARDY REFERRALS OCCUR ON EVERY 4TH TARDY.

If you are not **physically inside the classroom** when the bell rings, you will need to go to the attendance office to obtain a pass, so the office or I can mark you tardy, excused, or late.

Please note the attendance failure policy on page 9 in your student agenda, "If a student accumulates 4 or more unexcused absences from any class period during any grading period, the student may become ineligible to participate in any extra or co-curricular activities until absences are excused."

Classroom Procedures

- * **Bell Ringers and Notes**- We complete a bell ringer most days. These will be collected on Fridays. You **MUST** take the notes we complete- these will be written in the composition notebooks I provide. I collect and grade notes on occasion.
- * **Homework**- You will have projects, etc. on occasion. You may have homework as needed.
- * **Make-up Work/Late Work**- **you have 1 day/absence to make up work**. Any make-up quiz or test must be done at lunch or after school, not during class. Late work will be accepted for reduced credit.
- * **Restroom Passes**- you get 4 restroom/water passes per quarter. Any unused passes will be entered as extra credit at the end of the quarter (5 pts/pass).
- * **Quiz/Test & Movie Day Procedure**- You must place your book bags and personal belongings in the front of the room on these days. Only your quiz/test paper and a pencil/pen will be allowed at your desks during testing. You may retrieve your belongings once everyone has finished.

Cheating/Plagiarism

Cheating of any form will not be tolerated. Cheating/Plagiarism includes, but is not limited to: using Google Translate or a similar translator (ex. Spanishdict.com), copying another student's work, and unauthorized group work (i.e. working on an assignment with someone else without asking for my permission **BEFORE** working on the assignment together). Please be mindful that anything you complete in this class **MUST** be your own work and yours alone.

Per the policy on page 7 in your student agenda, "if a student is caught, the following will occur:


1. The student will receive an **F with zero (0) credit**.
