Writing – students will learn the invaluable skill of argument support. When looking at works of art it is important to not only form opinions and arrive and conclusions, but to support those opinions with concrete evidence.

Turner's brushwork may have influenced some of Monet's later landscapes, Monet did not share the older artist's commitment to feeling or to narrative. He said simply, 'The Romantics have had their day.' Instead, he painted simple moments, capturing the play of light quickly before it changed."
