SAC Meeting Minutes—August 21, 2018

- The meeting was brought to order at 6pm by Mr. Minor
- Mr. Minor made a motion for the approval of the July Minutes—Approval pending update report from Mr. Williams

Returned Mail and Lunch Process

Assistant Principal, Mr. Ansley presented the report on returned report cards and the lunch process.

- Mr. Ansley opened a brown envelope with the remainder of report cards that have been returned due to bad addresses.
 - The number of reports cards left is about 35—down from approximately
 150
 - Among the list of students with returned report cards, most are in regular attendance
- To maintain order in the cafeteria, Mr. Ansley insists students stand in a single-file line or seated at a table
 - o There are 2 general lines and 1 a la carte line
 - Students are asked to leave the tables; and go outside when finished eating—this should alleviate the problem with students not finding a place to sit and eat
 - o Lunch begins at 11:17 and lasts about 45 minutes

TAC Report

Mrs. Marie Claire-Leman gave an update for the Title I Advisory Council. She stated Rickards had good representation; and reiterated the following focus points:

- Best Practices @ Title I
 - Sharing of other Title I schools' grades from across the state
 - Benchmarking other Title I schools and learning about how they get good school grades—also seeing how Rickards compares with these schools
- Principal needs
- Parental Involvement
- Advocate for Title I schools
- Commonalities among Title I Schools
- Re-segregation of our schools with School Choice
- Early Childhood Education
- Partnership with Local Providers
- · Community Members' understanding of Title I Grant
- Mental and Physical Health

Mrs. Claire-Leman mentioned two areas of concern:

- Hope Scholarship—a new law regarding car dealerships to opt for providing scholarships to students (who have been bullied in school) to attend a private school.
- Sufficiently investing in elementary schools that feed into Title I secondary-level schools

SAC continues to solicit a volunteer to serve as Rickards High School representative for TAC

Principal Report

Remodeling and renovations continue to progress as planned with some delays due to weather-related issues. The local area has received a significant amount of rain during the summer and fall. Overall students have been resilient and adjusted well.

- o Baseball and softball fields holding water
- o Track will be resurfaced in October
- The 500-wing building has been up-rooted for construction of phase I of a 2-story building, with a bridge to the cafeteria. Construction is scheduled to begin in October.
- o Classrooms have been moved to accommodate changes
- Mr. Cook is working with the Department of Transportation, city officials and the immediate community on efforts to calm the traffic on Jim Lee Road. People are driving too fast and hastily in a school zone area.

In terms of scheduling updates:

- Rickards is using a new system for student placement in classes
- Dr. McNeil oversees scheduling IB students
- Dr. Barnes oversees scheduling all students
- School officials have focused on reducing class sizes before October 1
 - o Approximately 98% scheduled and on target for graduation

Parents were encourage to review the Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) and provide feedback during Open House and/or at the September SAC meeting. Draft copies of the PFEP were distributed.

- Mr. Minor mentioned the school website is showing signs of improvement.
 Information is returning to the official website with more of a standardized format for sports and other student organizations.
