



What's in Passport?

Resources Available:

- You have access to all resources (books/materials) for **all levels**.
- Your view defaults to the grade level you were previously viewing.
- Use the filters to easily access other levels or filter by Type or Resource. You can also use the Search.

When you open the online platform, you are in the Teacher View:

Click on a demo class. You can navigate the Teacher View using these features:

- **Course Dashboard:** Manage your class roster under **Students**. Under **Assignments**, view the status of work you've assigned, offer feedback, and adjust or delete assignments.
- **Assignments Library:** Send interactive activities to your students or create your own activities to meet your students' needs.
- **Score Reports:** View student scores, edit existing scores, and add scoring notes.

Next, you can review *Mirrors & Windows* from the Student View:

View Passport from a student's perspective by clicking on a student's name from your **Course Dashboard**. Click on the blue **Launch Student View** link. Make sure you check out these features:

- **Student Dashboard:** View all assignments.
- **Resources:** Click on the white book icon in the upper right corner to view student resources including eBooks, tools, and videos.
- **Feedback:** Review results of an assignment or gather any written feedback by clicking on an evaluated assignment.
- **Message Center:** Receive information about Passport updates and information sent from that teacher.
