



# EXPORTING AS AN .MOV in Premiere Pro CC


1. Export your final video using the File → Export → Media commands





Click on your Export Settings and change your format to “QuickTime”.



Click on “Output Name” and you will make 2 changes here. No. 1: Change the folder location to your appropriate folder. No. 2: Change the name of the file to the corresponding project name.




Find the Video Tab and locate the Video Codec. You will change the Video Codec to “Animation”. And Uncheck the “Audio Box”



Scroll down to under the aspect and locate the Depth.

Change the Option from “8-bpc” to “8-bpc + alpha”



## EXPORT SETTINGS:

FORMAT: QuickTime


PRESET: Custom

OUTPUT NAME: Customize it

EXPORT AUDIO: Uncheck

VIDEO CODEC: Animation

DEPTH: 8-bpc + alpha



Zoom Version:

Click “Export” (located at the very bottom) and Double check your folder and be sure that your final .MOV is present. Verify that the file is transparent by importing it into your bin and placing a solid behind it.
