



Hours of Operation: 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. We are also open before school and during lunch.

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
WHAT WE EXPECT OF OUR STUDENT BODY:

How did Black History Month begin?

"As a Harvard-trained historian, Carter G. Woodson, (...) believed that truth could not be denied and that reason would prevail over prejudice. His hopes to raise awareness of African American's contributions to civilization was realized when he and the organization he founded, the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History (ASNLH), conceived and announced Negro History Week in 1925. The event was first celebrated during a week in February 1926 that encompassed the birthdays of both Abraham Lincoln and Frederick Douglass. The response was overwhelming: Black history clubs sprang up; teachers demanded materials to instruct their pupils; and progressive whites, not simply white scholars and philanthropists, stepped forward to endorse the effort." -The Library of Congress

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


