

What are the major parts of the circulatory system and its functions?

- 1. Heart
- 2. Blood vessels
- 3. Blood

Blood vessels:

- 1. arteries
- 2. capillaries
- 3. veins

- Humans and pigs have a4 chambered heart
- The 2 atria are the receiving chambers
- The 2 ventricles are the discharging chambers
- Arteries carry blood away
- Veins carry blood to the heart
- Low pressure-atria
- High pressure-ventricles
