By signing this form:

1. You are taking responsibility for the care of the instrument and bow which are assigned to you.

Please follow these guidelines for the care of your instrument:

- Wipe rosin from your instrument with a soft cloth.
- Never touch the bow hair with your hands.
- Do not hit anything with the tip of the bow.
- Loosen the bow hair after every use to prevent warping of the stick.
- Tighten the bow the same amount every time before playing. Make sure your bow has a "smile".

Special to Violins and Violas:

- Always lay the case flat before opening it.
- Never place the instrument on the floor or other surfaces without its case.
- Place a cloth over your instrument before closing the case.
- Never force the case closed. If it won't close, look for obstructions and ask for help.
- Be sure to latch the case.

Special to Cellos and Basses:

- Please carry the instrument correctly. Your teacher will show you how.
- Never lean the instrument against the wall.
- Never leave your instrument where others may trip over or step on it.
- You are agreeing to be responsible for the expense of any repairs which must be made upon the instrument as a result of improper use or accident. Please do not attempt to repair the instrument. Tell your teacher if something needs to be fixed.
