

K-ulture Club Bylaws

Article I: Organizational Status

Section I - The name of this organization shall be K-ulture Club

Section II- Kulture club of James S. Rickards High School acknowledges the need for spreading South Korean Culture amongst teens. It also recognizes the demand of wanting to learn about other cultures of the world, so this club will help others learn more about Korean culture.

Article II – Membership and Fees

Section I – The K-ulture club is about introducing and exploring aspects of Korean culture. It will be open to anyone with intentions to join regardless of race, color, orientation, gender, religion, or age.

Section II – The sponsor (Ms. Figueroa) and officers will all be considered as members of the club and are not above the rules of the club.

Section III – Mandatory dues will be 20 dollars per club member, although this is subject to change each year.

Section IV- Members do not have the required attendance rate. However, dues will not be refunded even if members choose not to come to meetings.

Article III – Officers and Election Procedures

Section I – In order to be eligible to run for an officer position of K-ulture club, candidates must be a paid member of the K-ulture club and be a participating member of the club.

Section II – If a vacancy occurs in the officer board of K-ulture club, the other officers will discuss upon a replacement officer, keeping the runner up for the position the first in mind.

Section III – The description of the board and officers are as follows

(a) President

- Speaks on behalf of the club at all participating events
- Oversees all meetings and decisions made as a club
- Ensures all officers are promptly doing their given tasks

(b) Vice President of Operations

- Aids the president in making decisions and overlooking the club
- Responsible in planning out fundraisers alongside the CFO
- Organizes meetings alongside the President

(c) Vice President of Finance

- Handles all the funds of the club
- Works with sponsor about the usage of funds and where club dues are spent
- Handles and organizes receipts of all spendings

(d) Historian

- Takes pictures at all meetings
- Handles the club Instagram and other social media
- Curates posters for advertisement

(e) Secretary

- Creates all powerpoints for meetings
- Uses the club email to send out email recaps, reminders, etc.
- Takes attendance at each meeting

Section IV – Elections will occur during April every year. These elections will be decided on the officer board for the following year. Officers may retain their spot or run for a higher position.

Section V – If an officer is not performing their duties, the sponsor may first give the officer a warning. If no change is made, the officer may be removed based on the sponsor's judgement. The impeached officer may continue to join the club as a regular member and may run for the position again in the following year.

Article IV – Amendment

Section I – Amendments to the club’s bylaws can be made through approval from the sponsor. If members have any suggestions for the club, they can discuss it with the sponsor or officers. Then the sponsor and officers will decide whether the change is beneficial to the club.
