Article One: Organizational Status

- **A.** The name of the organization shall be the Rickards High School Knitting Club, hereinafter referred "Yarn or Dye",

Article Two: Purpose

shall present their grievances directly to the club's higher ups, who will consult with the

sponsor and to determine an appropriate response to the grievance.
