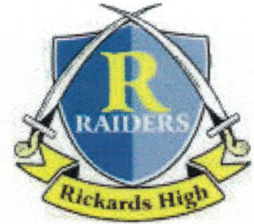

SAC Meeting Minutes—November 15, 2018

- The meeting was brought to order at 6pm by Mr. Minor
- Mr. Minor made a motion for the approval of the September minutes. Minutes were approved

Principal Report

Hurricane Michael

- Students are resilient, continuing to work well with recent adjustments to scheduled events
- We are now into the soccer and basketball season

Construction

- Experienced several delays due to summer weather and Hurricane Michael
- Development of the baseball and softball fields, student and faculty parking still on schedule
- New fields are expected to be done January 15, 2019
- Materials have come in for construction of the first phase of the new building
- School officials are looking at new furniture
 - Hopefully new desks will fit all students
 - Patterns have been brought in for everyone to view

School Advertisement

- Students are currently working on a video to get the word out about Rickards High School and what is being offered.
- The school is working on a joint venture with Conley Elementary and Fairview Middle. The first meeting will be January 15.

Threats of Violence

- The school worked diligently to inform parents of a recent threat of violence. The threat came as a result of a disagreement over the election in social media.
- The school received an email about the threat
- The school sent two Listserve messages out to parents, assuring students' safety on campus.
- WCTV reported a different story about the threat, but did not interview any staff, students or parents.
- There were some technical difficulties with sending messages through the network from away from campus. Future messages will be sent from school to prevent firewalls and server issues. As of now, there is not enough information about FOCUS to send messages. The District is parceling out specific access to the schools.
- Traffic Report
- DOT is conducting a study of the area around the school

- Mr. Charles Williams suggested SAC works with city commission to add the traffic issue to the agenda at a future city commission meeting
- Ms. Wells suggested we find out which department is responsible for traffic improvements and signage around the area.

Student Progress

- Current enrollment is 1510
- Twenty-six seniors passed the untimed SAT.
