The digital version of Paths supports the management and dissemination of digitized curricular materials for administrators, teachers, and students. Core to the experience are features that help teachers implement the *Florida Paths* curriculum in their classroom, manage lessons and student activities, assign activities for students to complete, and track student progress and grade submitted work---all within their familiar learning management system (LMS) or PCG’s learning solution. Students are provided a student view of shared lessons, resources, and assignments; tools to read, annotate, and submit their work; and progress tracking views that help students identify assigned lessons and important due dates.




