- Recommended brands for flute: Gemeinhardt, Yamaha, Armstrong, Jupiter
- Tuning/cleaning rod (should come with flute)
- Cotton or silk swab. A cotton handkerchief is fine.
- A music stand for home practice

Oboe:

- Recommended brands for oboe: Fox, Yamaha, Selmer
- Four reeds
- A reed holder for four reeds
- Silk swab, preferably one that has a pull string on both ends

Bassoon:

- Recommended brands for bassoon: Fox, Yamaha, Selmer

Clarinet:

- Cork grease (any brand from a music store that looks like chap-stick)

Tuba:

Returning band students should have all the above equipment plus:

- Reed instruments should switch to Vandoren reeds or similar quality, strength 3
- Students should consider getting a "step-up" mouthpiece or instrument to replace their beginner model
- Percussion students must also have a pair of yarn keyboard mallets and a stick bag
