

Welcome

- Mr. Minor brought the meeting to order at 6 PM.
- Team members and new parents were greeted with a cordial welcome.

Approval of September 2019 minutes

• Mr. Minor asked for a motion for the approval of the September Minutes. Minutes were approved with corrections.


Title I Advisory Council Report

Mrs. Stachnik provided the team with the latest from TAC.

- TAC has moved its meetings back to Mondays (instead of Tuesdays); as meetings conflicted with several school SAC meetings.
- The amount of Title I funds for this year totals about \$655,000; which is down from previous years. The formula has been changed —meaning the monetary allocation has been reduced to only the number of students who qualify for free or reduced lunch. Mr. Cook mentioned Rickards has a different formula; which includes a separate allocation, minus 18-year-olds.
- There will be a Teacher Planning Day Summit for teachers at Godby High School. The summit will focus on several areas:
 - o Impact the Outcomes
 - o Conference Discipline @ Pineview
 - o Equity and Inclusion—Diane Cox-Williams
 - Housing Unity
- TAC continues to focus early childhood education. Based on April's presentation, TAC wants to work on providing targeted and comprehensive access to quality pre-K programs. This would be done by:
 - Increasing access for 3 and 4 year olds to pre-K programs in their zoned schools to increase number of kindergarten-ready children in Title I schools
 - Increasing outreach to families in Title 1 school zones, collaborating with Whole Child Leon, Early Learning Coalition, Head Start, etc.- offering more screening opportunities and information about their zoned Title 1 school.
 - Offer a full day for pre-K students.

In addition, TAC will also look at efforts to protecting and support struggling schools or those within the lowest 25%-30%.







District Advisory Council

Ms. Wells provided SAC with the latest report from DAC.

- Superintendent, Rocky Hanna stated the District will take seek another company that would be able to utilize the mapping system available by the County to streamline the bus routes and maintain real-time communication with parents.
- Maintenance and transportation workers were given pay increases. The Teachers Association is bargaining with the Florida Legislature to increase teacher pay.
- Rocky Hanna wants to align teachers' pay with the state average, by tightening the budget; and using money made available from new assignments and employee separation.
- Sabal Palm Elementary school has officially become the County's first Community School. The school is now partnering with local businesses as well as with FAMU and FSU
- Rickards will take the lead in working with other local high schools for Habitat for Humanity.
- The Voter Registration Drive will be expanded to all high schools
- Early Learning Coalition Director, Brooke Brunner is setting up visits to local private day care providers. The goal is to prepare our children (particularly Southside children) for entering kindergarten.
- Leon County Schools have received and have been re-accredited.

Regarding safety, Leon County School Board is working on developing the RAID app. This will be an Alert/Walkie-Talkie for appropriate responders to take immediate action in case of an emergency.

The District is developing a Mental Health Plan and curriculum to assist with early intervention. It is only in the development stages; as there is a growing concern with rushing into situations and using uncertified people to serve in areas outside their expertise.

Parents expressed concern over records not available through FOCUS. With upcoming mental health activities, parents want to know if there are any unknown records about their children.

All public records at Rickards High School are handled and made available by Julie Jernigan. Parents may request a public record concerning his/her own child.

- The main artery along Building 24 will be shut down until the end of the month.
- Building 13 is now under renovation
- Building 1 will have 5 additional offices by Spring
- Building 19 will have additional space with new furniture by Summer
- Library will be temporarily partitioned off for classroom space for 8 teachers. Changes will take place in July
- Chorus classes will meet in the auditorium
- 23 ft. egress out of building outlet to sidewalk and to auditorium.
