# Finding Your Information

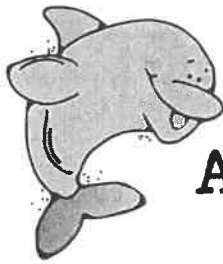
Where to look:


