Special Area Grading Policies

Physical Education

Leon County Schools have established a percentage policy for all instructional classes, which is reflected in the 80/20 breakdown.

80% of your child's grade is assessments. These will be given after a skill is introduced and practiced numerous times. Assessment will be based on the observations of the PE coaches. Please know that sometimes a child will not receive a 100% because they are still developing and may not have mastered the skill.

20% of your child's grade is participation. Each time your child comes to PE they will start with 33.33 points, 3 times a week will equal 100). For your child to earn all their points they must:

- 1. Be an active participant
- 2. Follow directions
- 3. Have a positive attitude
- 4. Dress appropriately

In the event that your child is injured or can't participate please email one of the PE coaches excusing them for the day.

All K-5 students will be graded on a 4 point grading scale for each project. The Art Grading policy is based on the student's demonstrations of concepts and skills learned, as well as effort and participation.

- 4) 90-100% = Student understands all concepts and techniques learned in class at a high level and participates to the best of their ability
- 3) 80-89% = demonstrates an understanding of techniques and puts in some effort of participation
- 2) 70-79% = does not demonstrate and understanding of techniques and concepts and has little participation.
- 1) 69% and below = does not demonstrate and understanding of techniques and concepts and has little participation.
