Middle School Promotion Requirements

Courses/Subjects	Course Requirements
English Language Arts	3 year-long middle school course credits
Mathematics	3 year-long middle school course credits. Middle school students enrolled in high school Algebra I or Geometry must pass the statewide, standardized end-of-course (EOC) exam to qualify for a standard high school diploma.
Science	3 year-long middle school course credits. Middle school students enrolled in Biology I must earn a passing score for the course and take the statewide, standardized Biology I EOC assessment to earn high school credit for the course.
Social Science	3 year-long middle school course credits. Students must successfully complete a civics course during middle school.
Physical Education	1 semester-long course in grades 6, 7, and 8. This requirement may be waived under the following conditions: 1) The student is enrolled in a remedial course. 2) The student's parent requests in writing that the student enroll in another course. 3) The student participates in physical activities outside the school day, which are equal to or in excess of the mandated requirement. No Action needed for Physical Education Waiver
