Syllabus

Text: Health Opportunities through Physical Education - Classroom Textbook only.
Replacement Fee: \$96.00

Classroom Days: Monday and Tuesday

Dress Days: Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday

Items Required:

Physical Education uniform—
Mandatory PE T-shirt and PE shorts \$20.00 for the set, \$8 shirt, \$12 shorts
Tennis shoes – with laces (no flip flops or boat shoes)
Socks
PE Lock- \$5
3-prong folder
Pencils/Notebook paper.

Classroom Procedure:

1. No Hats or hoodies.
2. Be prepared
3. Listen.
4. Remain seated.
5. No cell phones or technology at desk.
6. No sleeping.
7. Be respectful of people and property.
8. No food or drinks in class. (You may have water.)

Dress Procedures/Locker Room Procedures:

1. Students buy a lock from the PE Dept. and are assigned a locker by the teacher
2. Students must wear **PE uniforms**- red shorts, gray shirt, socks, and tennis shoes
3. 5 minute dress in and dress out period
4. Sharing lockers is NOT permitted
5. No electronics, food, or drinks (except water and gatorade) permitted during activity days or in the classroom
6. Students who do not dress out will still be required to walk the track or walk around the gym unless a doctor's note has been provided.

Academic Integrity:

Academic integrity violations can include plagiarism, cheating, and unauthorized group work on any assignment, project, or test.

If caught, the following will occur:

- The student will receive an F with zero (0) credit.
- The citizenship grade will be lowered.
- A notice will be recorded with the guidance office.

Behavior Consequences:



1. Oral warning by teacher.
2. Conference with teacher.
3. Call or Email parents. If note or call not returned, the student will receive a 2 (needs improvement) in citizenship for that 9-weeks.
4. Referral to office. Citizenship grade may be lowered to a 1 (unsatisfactory behavior).

Tardy Consequences:

- 1st & 2nd infraction—verbal warning
- 3rd infraction—lunch detention
- 4th infraction—administrative detention and tardy counts as a class "late"

Leon Attendance Policy:

Every time you are absent from class you are expected to bring a note from home that is signed by a parent. This note should explain the reason you were absent. Please take the note to the Attendance Office at Leon High School immediately after the absence. Please remember that you must sign out for any appointments.

Exam Policy:

1. To exempt the semester exam, a student must meet all Leon High School exemption policies, and must maintain an "A" average for both 9-weeks of the semester and adhere to attendance policy. The student must complete their 10 minute run in semester 1 or 20 minute run to be exempt from Semester exam 2. The semester runs are 50% of exam grades.
2. A student cannot be absent 10 or more days in any one 9-week period(exempting school field trips, of course). This policy is also enforced for seniors.
