

Sample Questions

Students to look at the provided visuals and verbalize their response before placing it onto the page. Students with limited verbal communication could point to the appropriate visual in response to the questions or use an AAC device.

Who questions

- Who is eating?
- Who is yelling?
- Who does Pig live with?
- Who does Trevor want to be friends with?
- Who fell out the window?
- Who is hugging Pig?

Where questions

- Where do Pig and Trevor live?
- Where do you think Pig fell to?

What questions

- What is Pig eating?
- What is Pig collecting?
- What did Pig fall through?
- What is Pig wrapped in?

Action Verb questions. Examples of different levels of prompting

- What is Pig/Trevor doing? (show array of visuals)
- What is Pig/Trevor doing? Is he running or is he eating? (show two visuals)
- Look, Pig is eating. What is Pig doing? (Show only correct visual)

Emotions/Feelings

- How did Trevor feel when Pig didn't share with him? (disappointed/sad)
- How does Trevor feel asking Pig to share (nervous)
- How does Pig feel when he is asked to share (angry)
- How does Pig feel as his standing on the pile of things (silly)
- How would you feel if thought you were about to fall? (scared)
- How did Trevor feel when he saw the pile wobbling? (worried/nervous)
- How did Pig feel after he fell from the window? (hurt/sad)
- How does Trevor feel now that Pig has to share? (happy/content)

*Please note there is often more than one correct response to emotion questions.
