- Please make sure your child has on their summer camp shirt & comfortable shoes. They can wear a swimsuit under their clothes since many campers will ride water rides. You can provide them with towel; and flip flops to wear while in the water park area.
- Park rules do not allow patrons to wear denim on the water rides, so please do not send your child in denim.
- Please apply sun block on your child. DTES Summer Camp can not be held responsible for applying sun block.

Field Trip Payment Policy - No Cash Accepted

For the upcoming summer camp field trips, we are no longer able to accept any form of cash for student purchases. To ensure a smooth and hassle-free experience, we strongly encourage parents to provide students with a prepaid debit card.

Prepaid Debit Card Guidelines:

- Prepaid debit cards can be used for **treats**, **additional beverages**, **and souvenirs** at Wild Adventures.
- While not required, this method is **highly encouraged** for convenience and security.

Turning in Prepaid Debit Cards:

- On **the Monday of the field trip**, prepaid debit cards can be turned in along with any required printed documents from the summer camp checklist.
- Write your child's name on the back of the card using a Sharpie.
- Note the amount on the field trip form to help with tracking.

Thank you for your cooperation in ensuring a smooth and organized process for our summer camp field trips!

- If you give your child money for souvenirs make sure it is enclosed in a hip-pouch that has a zipper or snap.
- If your child complains of being ill, please do not send them today. The heat may only make the illness worse. Please call us and let us know they will be out.
- Campers will be placed in groups of 3-5 that includes one adult counselor/chaperone.

- Campers will be given a meal (lunch) card and will eat lunch at 1:00 pm with their counselor. They **do not** need to bring their own lunch. Unless your child has a specific dietary restriction. Please notify camp Director/Asst. Mgr if this is the case via email.
- Please be on time students need to arrive before 8:00 a.m. for check-in and breakfast. Our headcount, group round-up, bathroom break and announcements will begin at 8:00 am. **DEPARTURE IS 9:00 am sharp**; return is at 6pm if there is any change parents will be notified via the summer camp 2025 Remind. As much as we want everyone to go on this trip, once we depart, we will not be able to wait or stop on the side of the highway to pick up a camper.
- NO Students are not allowed in the Catchawave Bay Wave Pool /Paradise River Lazy River
- 3rd-6th grade students are allowed to ride the following water park rides with a chaperone and park provided life vest. Kalani Blasters, Kona Cliffs, Wakee Cyclone, Hakini Rapids Bonzai Pipelines.
- **K-2nd grade students** are allowed to enjoy Polynesian Adventure, Sea Turtle Cove & Ohana Bay.
- Campers will not be allowed to ride any rides without a counselor or any rides they are not tall enough to ride.
 - We do not leave our assigned group with another chaperone to go shopping.
