- The applicant must sign and date the application.
- Must complete the application in its entirety.
- Attach most recent transcript (can be unofficial); note transcript may be subject to verification if chosen.
- Letters of recommendation will be accepted (but are not required).
- Minimum 250 to 400 word essay “*What Community Service and Paying it Forward Means to Me*”
