- have good conduct and behavior in the community and at school
- present a typewritten/single spaced, 500-word essay on one of the following topics:
“The Importance of Being a Productive Citizen”
“The Importance of Getting a Good Education”
“Why I Want to Attend a Post-Secondary Institution”

All information must be placed in an 8 ½ X 11 envelope. Do not staple or fold any of the materials. The materials may have a gem clip to hold them in place.
