DON'T DO IT! Try Chiles Band one year! It will change your life, for the better! If after one year you find band is not for you, then we will help you find something that is a better fit.

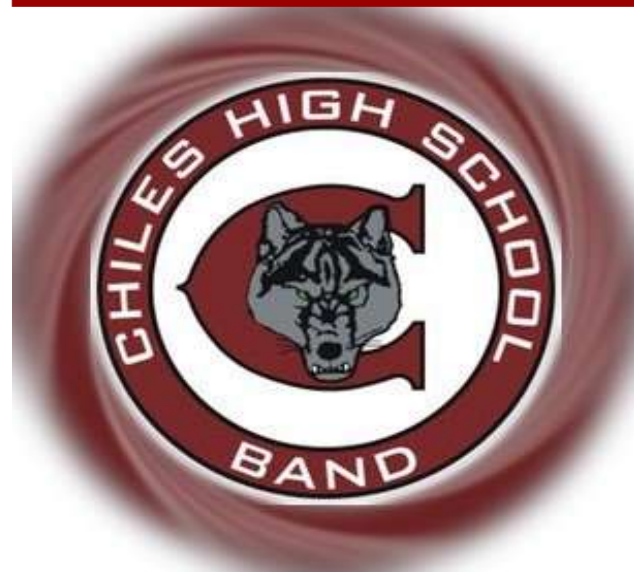

The Chiles Bands are among the best in the Southeastern United States. The Marching, Concert, and Jazz Bands consistently earn Superior ratings at the Florida Bandmasters Association (MPA) Music Performance Assessments and received the prestigious Otto J. Kraushaar Award in 2011.

The Chiles Band performed the World Premiere of "Mysterious Presence" by Bob Thurston in the Spring of 2006 with the composer in attendance.

In 2005, the Chiles Symphonic Band was one of only 38 bands in Florida to be rated Superior at the State Concert MPA.

BRASS CHOIR: Meets after school and gives various performances throughout the year.

WOODWIND CHOIR: Meets after school and gives various performances throughout the year.

AP MUSIC THEORY: Open to Juniors and Seniors with Instructor approval. This is a preparatory course for those taking the AP Exam in Music Theory.
