## Online Math Testing

The second nine weeks the students will be completing the math chapter tests on paper and then transferring their answers online. The third nine weeks the students will complete all math assessments online. ANOTHER reason for them to make sure they are reading all directions/questions carefully and applying the strategies we are learning in class.

<u>Multiplication facts</u>: This week we will start with 0's and 1's, then 2's and 4's, 5's and 10's, 3's and 6's, and finally, 7's, 8's, and 9's. The "Big Mix" is just around the corner!
